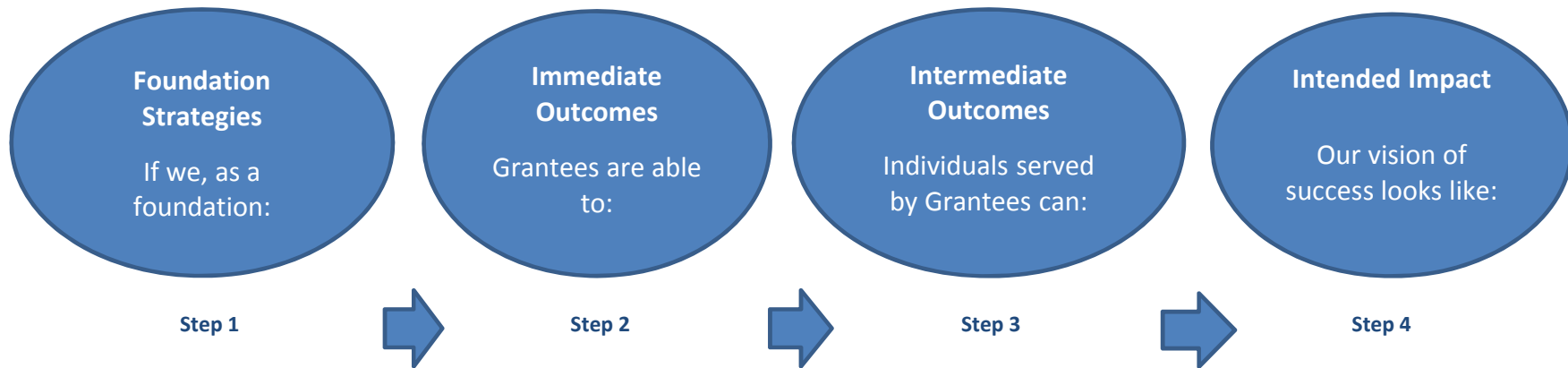


Coleman Foundation Cancer Impact Plan

Cancer patients must be fully engaged in development of a treatment plan and empowered to make decisions regarding their continuity of care.

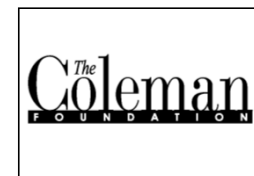
Health Care Providers
